About PCR Oncology:

- The guiding principal for the practice is the idea of treating our patients and one another as we wish to be treated.
- As a result of this we have constantly innovated and made choices that are in the best interests of our patients.

Examples:

- We are the only practice in more than a 90-mile radius to have joined the National Cancer Institute Community Oncology Research Program (NCORP – see NCORP.cancer.gov for more information). This gives us access to about 75 NCI-sponsored clinical trials at any time. This is the size of research programs at some university cancer centers.
- Participation in the NCORP results in regular audits of quality of care and quality of research (by the National Cancer Institute). We have passed all of our audits, assuring you that we provide high quality care.
- Nine of the twelve medical oncologists in the region are employed by a local hospital, which bills nearly twice what physician-owned practices bill. We are one of the few in the region to resist selling to a hospital. Thus the cost of care at PCR Oncology is much lower that at most of our competitors.
